# A. Chromebooks

Superintendent, Amy McKinstry provided an update on chromebooks, devices, and technology. She shared current number of chromebooks requested by students and staff. Amy gave an update of current number of chromebooks in the district as well as a small number of iPads that have been retrofitted to accommodate remote learning. The distribution will start Tuesday, September 8<sup>th</sup> and run through Thursday, September 10<sup>th</sup>. We are able to outfit all of the desktops in the buildings with cameras and speakers to prepare for remote learning/teaching in all of the classrooms.

#### B. Handbook Addendums

Superintendent, Amy McKinstry shared COVID-19 Handbook Addendum with the committee. This addendum is in addition to the Student and Faculty Handbook. This will supersede the normal handbook for the items covered in the addendum. Both handbooks are important to read and are relevant. This COVID-19 Handbook Addendum covers all requirements regarding mask wearing, social distancing, drop off and pick up procedures, tardy procedures, visitors and item drop-off procedures, recording of virtual instruction is prohibited, as well as online learning expectations. Amy talked about how offenses would be disciplined. Mask wearing is the number one way to mitigate the spread of COVID-19 and is mandatory while in any and all of the Northbridge Public School buildings. Buildings will have signage and areas will be marked appropriately to remind everyone of the social distancing.
