Re: New Balmer School Borrowing

On September 19, 2019, the Town of Northbridge undertook the first major step in helping to pay for the new Balmer School. The Treasurer/Collector bonded the first installment of the project totaling \$30 million dollars. The bond was awarded to UMB Bank out of Dallas, Texas. There were eight bids that came in, and UMB was selected with an interest rate of 2.79%. This included a premium of \$2 million which will be used to pay project costs first, then the remainder of the temporary note that was take our prior to the close of Fiscal 2019 to avoid a project deficit.

The first principal payment is due June 1, 2020 for \$1,000,000. Interest on the first year of the note will be \$739,000. The repayment of this will commence on this year's tax bills, which will be issued in late December of 2019, and due February 1, 2020.

The Town saved approximately \$5.8 million dollars over the life of the loan based on earlier estimates, which projected an interest rate of 4.5% for 30 years. I have attached schedules showing the original estimate and the final borrowing schedule.

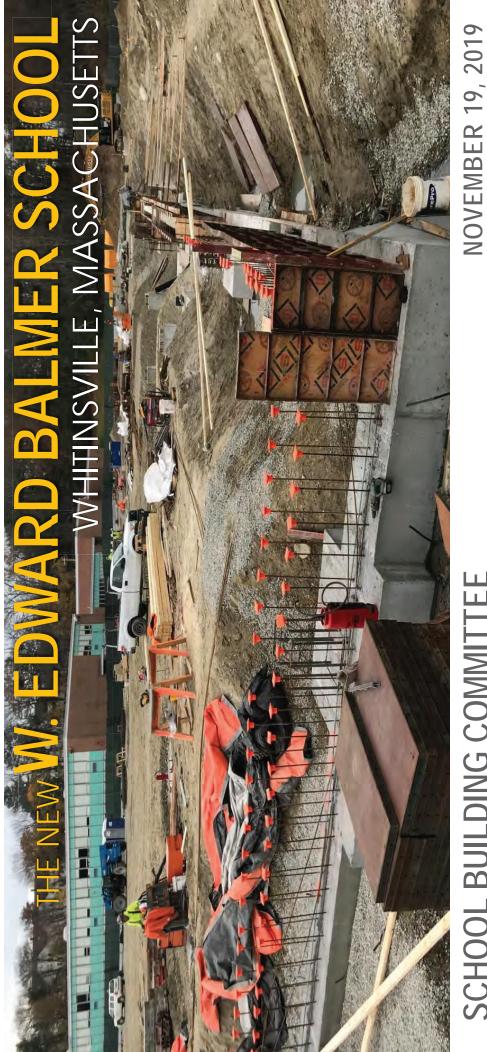

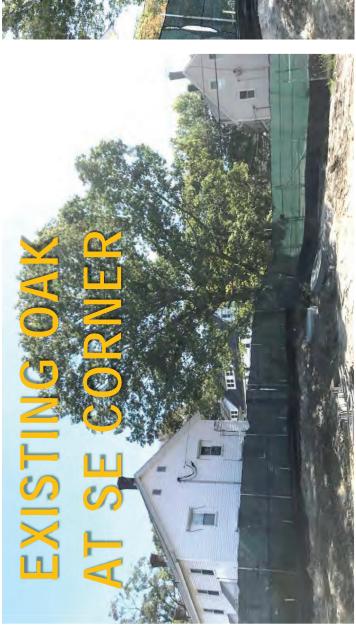

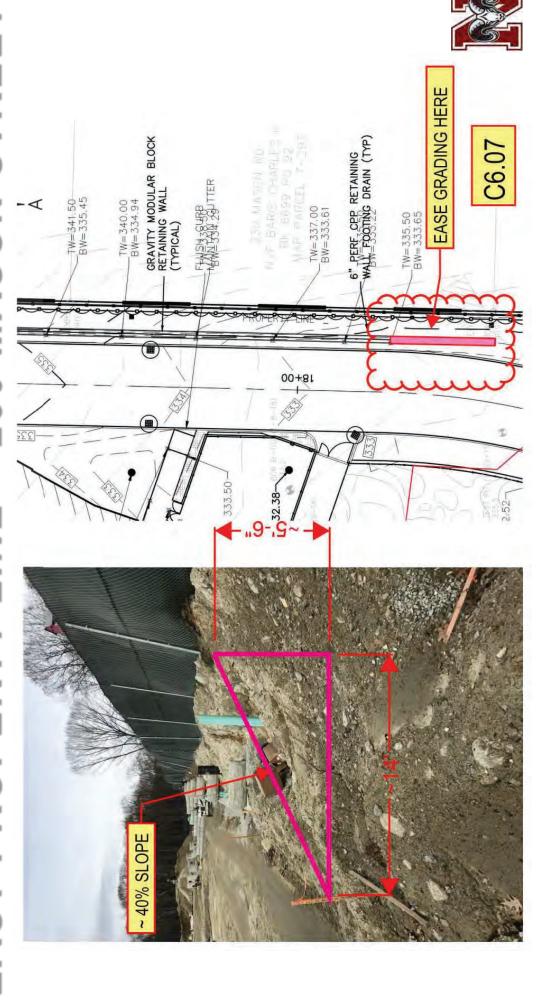
EAST PROPERTY LINE - 230 MASON STREET

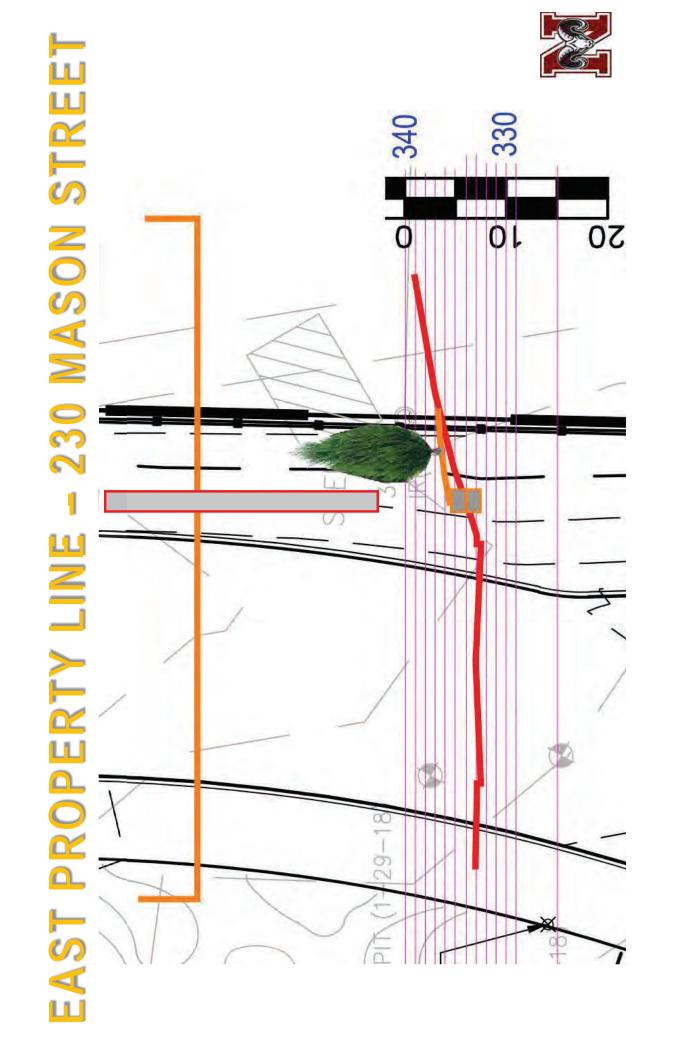


Estimated Cost pending – new issue as of 11/12

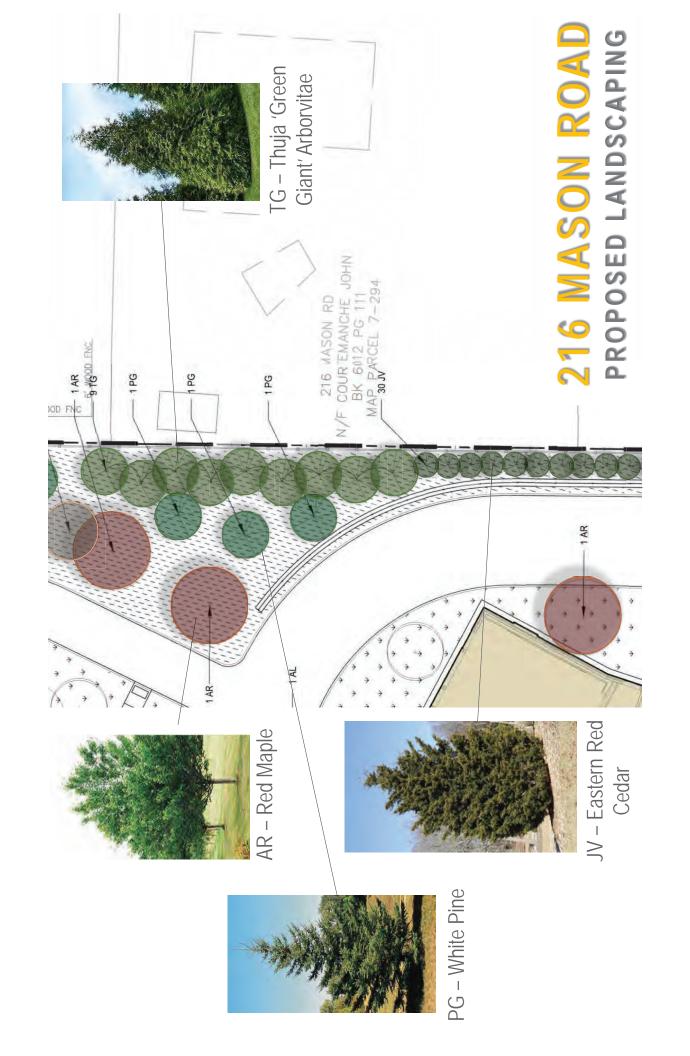

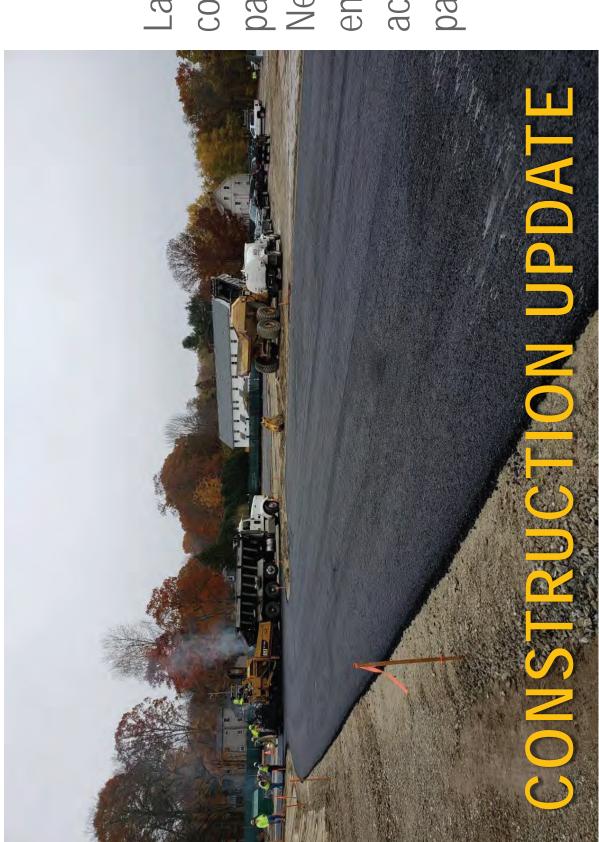

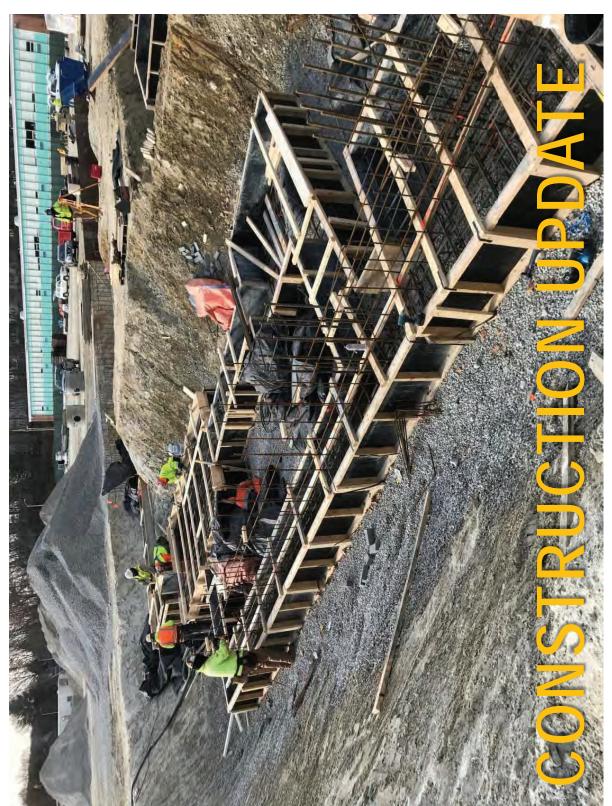
